2. The highest bidder to be the Purchaser and no bidding shall be retracted after the hammer has fallen. The Auctioneers reserve the right to refuse any bidding and in the event of any dispute.
3. Reserve Prices and Provisional Sales - All Lots are put up for sale, subject to any reserve price imposed by the Vendor. Some lots may have reserve prices and the final highest bid on a lot may be subject to acceptance by the seller, if the reserve is higher. The highest final bidder on a lot is contractually obliged to stand by that bid, if it is accepted by the seller.
4. The description of the various Lots is believed to be correct. For the guidance of the Purchasers, approximate weights or measures of each Lot are given in this Catalogue, but it must be emphasised that this is given for guidance only. No warranty as to weight, quality or condition can be given and any intending Purchaser shall be deemed to have inspected the Lot in which he/she is interested.
5. **All Lots are sold for card payment or BACS transfer and must be paid for within 24 hours of the Timed Online Auction ending.**

6. A Deposit of £500 will need to be paid to participate in the Timed Online Auction. Please note that all deposits are to be paid via Sagepay. No deposits will be taken over the phone. This is a "reserved payment" system whereby your money will only be taken when you have successfully purchased or become the highest bidder on a lot and goes towards the total purchase price. The purchaser will then be responsible to pay the remaining amount due.

Unsuccessful purchasers should note that refunds of deposits can take approximately 3 - 5 days and you will get an email at the time we have processed the release from our side.

7. All Lots must be removed as stated in the Catalogue and if not so removed, the Purchaser shall pay the Vendor a penalty of £20 per week for each week or part week until final clearance or forfeit the balance of the Lot at the Vendor's discretion. The Purchaser shall indemnify the Vendor for any damage that may be caused to gates, fences etc. in the course of the removal of any Lot.



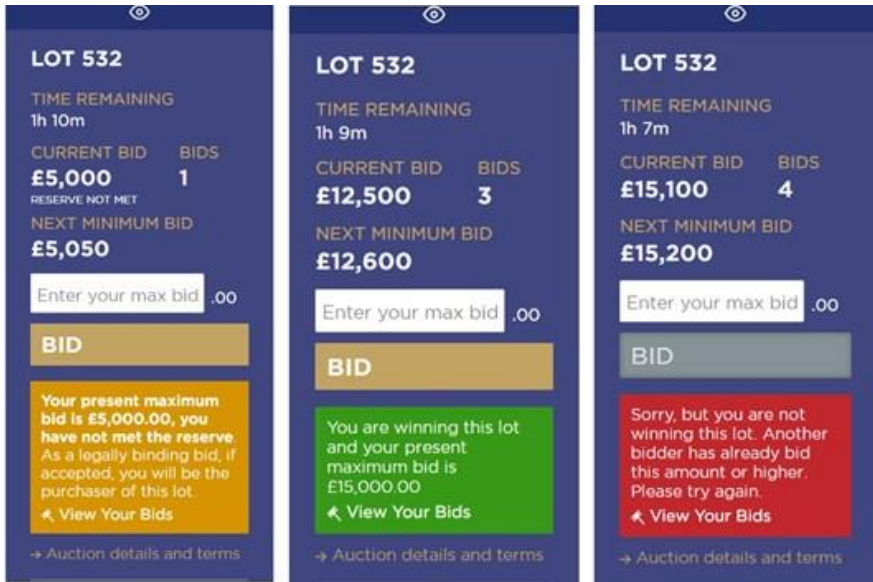

4. After placing a bidding deposit of £500, click onto the Lot(s) you wish to purchase and put in your highest bid you would be prepared to go to, at your earliest opportunity. Waiting to bid until the final few seconds may be risky, if others also bidding at that time.
5. When bidding, the system treats your bid differently depending on whether the Vendor has placed a reserve price on the lot.  
If your bid has the value up to or at the reserve, the bid will be taken at it's maximum to the reserve.  
If the lot has no reserve or if your bid is forced above the reserve by other bidders, then an increment table operates that the system follows, similar to other bidding platforms. The bidding will automatically increase your bid in increments outbidding other bidders up to your maximum bid.  
You will be notified by email and under your Brightwells 'My Bids Page' if you have been outbid, so you can decide whether to bid more.  
Example of automatic bidding increments: £2 increment up to £50; £5 increment up to £100; £10 increment up to £200; £20 increment up to £500; £25 increment up to £1000; £50 increment up to £10,000. You may pay less than your maximum bid if you win.



6. Winning bidders will be emailed on the next working day after the auction. The Auctioneers may withdraw Lots at any time. If you are the successful bidder on one or more than one lot that is sold to you, provisionally or outright, the bids are binding and you cannot withdraw any bids - you will be liable for all lots sold to you.
7. The Timed Online Auction starts from 10am Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> January 2024 and finishes on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> January 2024 from 12noon.
8. Each lot finishes every 30 seconds. As an example, Lot 1 finishes on 12noon Friday 19<sup>th</sup> January 2024, Lot 2 30 seconds thereafter, Lot 3 30 seconds thereafter etc.
