The highest priced horse at Brightwells Ascot October Sale was Lot 41, Rajeh, which made £25,000 an eight-year-old son of Key Of Luck. Consigned by Kinnersley Racing Stables, the gelding has been running on the flat and over hurdles for his trainer John Spearing

He is a half-brother to the Gr.3 Oh So Sharp Stakes-third Hasty (Invincible Spirit), from the family of the young sires Air Chief Marshal and Misu Bond.
