

# Strong demand & quality in abundance



**The 2010 August 'Stars of the Future' attracted a large audience who enjoyed a great night with quality horses on offer with strong demand throughout which saw a new record set for a show jumper sold at public auction in Great Britain.**

*£70,000 sterling for Lot 72 Fleur vd Schelpenhoueve  
5 year old mare by Lux z – Narcos II – Jokinal d Bornival*

The beautiful 5 year old mare Fleur VD Schelpenhouve by Lux Z out of a Narcos III thrilled the audience with her exceptional jumping the day before when she was required to jump in the International Arena over the 5 year old Championship course set up for the British Young Horse Championships. Bidding started at £20,000 after the auctioneer stated that she was once of the best young horses to have been offered for sale at Brightwells Stars of the Future Sale in the last 5 years. She was eventually sold for £70,000 to Old Lodge Stud whose past successful horses purchased at these sales include Super Trooper Des Ness, Ja Wahar.

She was offered for sale by Brightwells Belgium Agent Danny Telen who was also responsible for Bizet a 4 year old mare by Vancouver out of a Burggraaf, she sold for £35,000 to John Hales the owner of Arko III.

Broodmares were also in demand with a 4 year old mare called B by Cartano out of a Heartbreaker mare and in foal to a son of Arko III called Arko's Boy selling for £20,000, she was offered for sale by Will Schellekens from Holland.

The top priced Dressage horse was offered as a Wild Card by Matthiue Beckman and Ulli Keuter she was a beautiful 4 year old mare by Don Frederico who the week before had been placed 3rd in her first Young Horse Class in Germany, the eventual bid came at £24,000.

The Foal Auction the evening before proved to be a little harder work with a clearance rate of just under 50%. However the demand for the best bred was strong with a filly foal by Diamant de Semilly selling for £10,000 and a colt and a filly both by Cornet Obelinsky both selling for £6,100 with one going to Germany.
